

Board Powers And Responsibilities

Powers and mandatory duties of the Board are defined in the Colorado Constitution and in state statutes.

This Board considers that its most important function and purpose is to provide highly effective governance for Mapleton Public Schools' strategic student achievement effort. The Board's core roles and specific focus areas will be determined at its annual retreat prior to the opening of the school year.

Because all powers of the Board lie in its action as a group, individual Board members exercise authority over district affairs only as votes are taken at a legal meeting of the Board. The authority and responsibilities of individual Board members do not extend to execution of the policies that they adopt as a body but rather, the Board's role is to act collectively.

In other instances, an individual Board member has power only when the Board has lawfully delegated authority to him or her.
