

## **Income From School Shop Sales And Services**

The services provided and products offered for sale through various vocational-technical programs shall not be considered income-producing for the district.

Fees and prices shall be established on the basis of cost of the particular service, including insurance costs, supplies, materials and parts used. Charges except for required materials and parts shall be waived for students enrolled in the course and for nonprofit organizations.

The Board shall establish individual clearing accounts to receive monies from the various shops and laboratories offering products and services. These monies shall go into the current year operating account of the district at the end of the school year.
