

Admission of Non-Resident and Homeless Students/Tuition Charges

The parents or guardians of Colorado students who are not residents of this school district shall not be charged tuition and shall be admitted in accordance with the policy on inter-district choice/open enrollment. Homeless students shall be admitted and transported in accordance with applicable law and regulations promulgated by the District Administration.
