

Student Activities (Co-Curricular And Extra-Curricular)

School-Sponsored Programs

School-sponsored programs serve the community not only by providing information concerning the educational opportunities for its students but also by bringing to the public information regarding the functions, operations and programs of the district. In order that the public has as broad a base as possible upon which to form its judgments of the district, the Board encourages school-sponsored programs.

Extra-curricular Activities

The Board supports the concept that a wide variety of extra-curricular activities should be made available to students. However, participation in such activities is a privilege, not a right. Such activities shall be conducted in accordance with the following guidelines:

1. Activity offerings shall be of sufficient variety and number to meet the wide range of students' interests.
2. Most activities shall be an outgrowth of curriculum activities.
3. All participation shall be voluntary.
4. The goal for each child shall be a balanced program of academic studies and extra-curricular activities.
5. All activities shall be supervised and all clubs and groups shall have a faculty advisor.

Extra-curricular activities shall be approved by the Board. Senior high schools shall comply with the policies of the Colorado High School Activities Association.

Responsibility for scheduling and student conduct during extra-curricular activities shall rest with the principal of each school.
