

Crisis Response

When a crisis situation occurs within the school community, the effects are felt throughout the system, underscoring the importance of attending to the needs of both students and staff. In such situations, it is important that a timely and effective intervention be provided to those affected.

The Board directs the superintendent to establish a Crisis Response Team which will plan for and execute, in appropriate situations, interventions which will deal with emotional needs generated by a crisis situation. The team will be prepared to respond immediately when notified by appropriate district authorities that such an event has occurred.
