DISNEYLAND FUN & UNUSUAL FACTS

- Always known as both an animal lover and creative thinker, Walt Disney figured out a way to simultaneously keep his park clean and keep some four-legged friends fed. Hundreds of feral cats call Disneyland home. They take care of any rodent problems, have free roam of the place and are a surprising site to be seen by many visitors. Talk about a symbiotic relationship!
- Historically seen as a place of innovation and magic, the creations at Disney weren't limited to the parks
 and movies. Doritos were invented there! Frito-Lay owned a restaurant in Disneyland when the park
 opened in 1955 called Casa de Fritos. The restaurant came up with a simple way of re-purposing stale
 tortillas that would otherwise be thrown away by flavoring and frying them. After the fried tortilla snacks
 were a huge success with Disney guests, Frito-Lay transformed Doritos into a national brand.
- Insider's tip for the fanatics. Club 33 is the park's most exclusive attraction. This secret speakeasy in New
 Orleans Square has a 10-year waiting list and \$25,000 initiation fee. It seems steep until you consider that
 it's the only place in Disneyland that serves a full bar of alcohol. Now we're really talking VIP!
