Colorado State University Scholarship Application (CSUSA)

Use the CSUSA to apply for scholarships from your academic college (your major), from the Office of Financial Aid, and from other departments on campus. The application is available on RAMweb on October 1 and the deadline is March 1. Students may apply for the following scholarships by completing the CSU Scholarship Application

First Generation Award -

\$16,000 (\$4,000 per year) awards to students who demonstrate financial need, are admitted by March 1, have parents who did not receive bachelor's degrees, and who meet all other eligibility criteria. The selection process is very competitive and there are a limited number of awards available. Please note the First Generation Award essay will not be available until December 1.

Front Range Community College - FRCC Foundation Scholarship

Scholarship awards vary depending on the type of scholarship. However, most FRCC Foundation scholarships typically range from \$1,000 - \$5,000 for full-time students and \$500 - \$1,000 for part-time students. Scholarships are awarded for the academic school year and will be split between the Fall and the Spring semesters.

- Must be enrolled in Early Childhood Program
- Must have worked in Early Childhood facility for a minimum of 6 months
- Must be currently working a minimum of 20 hours/week in a licensed Early Childhood facility in Adams County
