

Global Campus MYP Academic Honesty Policy

Global Campus students are to uphold the highest standards of academic and personal integrity. Staff are determined to help students avoid unintentional plagiarism and academic misconduct, and understand the expectations of responsible scholarship.

Students and staff at Global embrace the ten learner profile attributes that are the backbone of the IB Model. Academic dishonesty compromises these attributes, in particular *principled*: to act with “integrity and honesty.” Students and staff will use reflective conversations to guide all interactions concerning academic dishonesty.

Academic misconduct includes:

- Incorrect/inadequate acknowledgement
 - Omission of quotation marks when using direct quotes and appropriate citation
 - Material paraphrased or summarized without appropriate citations
- Verbatim copying
 - Material copied word for word without any acknowledgement of the source
- Duplication
 - The presentation of the same work for different assessment components without teacher approval
- Collusion
 - Material copied from another student’s work *with* his/her knowledge
- Stealing
 - Material copied from another student’s work *without* his/her knowledge
- Ghost writing
 - Assignment written by or purchased from a third party and presented by a student as his/her own work.
- Other forms of academic misconduct
 - Any behavior that gives an unfair advantage to a student or that affects the results of another student (falsifying data, misconduct during an examination, creating fake reflections).
