

Regulation: Facilities Planning

The Board of Education (the “Board”) for Mapleton Public Schools (the “District”) recognizes that facility planning is an ongoing process that requires resources to carry out short and long-range facility planning responsibilities. The Superintendent shall establish a facilities planning process that includes:

1. Coordinating a process to identify, evaluate, validate, and document capital improvement needs, including the capital needs of District charter schools, if applicable;
2. Maintaining and updating a comprehensive list of capital improvement needs;
3. Maintaining complete and current educational and technical specifications;
4. Providing facility needs data and background information for development of short and long-range capital improvement programs;
5. Maintaining permanent facility project record documents and providing facility record information;
6. Conducting a thorough technical evaluation of proposed school sites;
7. Providing consultation, research, and information on facility matters; and,
8. Keeping abreast of educational program changes/trends and their impact on facilities.
