

Student Concerns, Complaints, and Grievances

Decisions made by school personnel which students of Mapleton Public Schools (the “District”) believe are unfair or in violation of pertinent District policies or individual school rules may be appealed to the school director or to the appropriate individual as designated in the corresponding appeal process (JII-R).

Grievance procedures are available for students to receive prompt and equitable resolution of allegations of discriminatory actions on the basis of race, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, sex, sexual orientation (which includes transgender), marital status, religion, disability, or need for special education services, which students are encouraged to report.

Adopted June 27, 2017, by the Board of Education for Mapleton Public Schools.
